1	<p>Introductions</p> <p>MW invited everyone to the meeting and asked all present to introduce themselves.</p>	
2	<p>Loxley Chapel & Cemetery</p> <p>WH was then requested to present the plans for the Loxley Chapel and associated cemetery. He explained that work had already started on clearing up the cemetery and that talks had started with Sheffield City Council about the possible transfer of the cemetery into their care. However the current owners were very keen that any proposals for the chapel and cemetery had the backing of the local community. MW stated that the results of the survey that had been conducted showed that the community supported the transfer of the cemetery to Sheffield City Council.</p> <p>WH then explained that the current owners of the Chapel were open to suggestions on how it could be developed. Current ideas were for either office space or residential use, however it was his belief that the latter was unlikely. WH reiterated that the current owners were open to ideas but emphasised that these must be profitable.</p>
